



Breaking the Homeless Cycle One Family at a Time

RENTAL & UTILITY ASSISTANCE

Providence House helps qualified Shreveport residents struggling to pay their rent or utilities. This program does not support mortgages.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a Shreveport resident
- Current lease agreement
- Evidence of need (eviction notice, past due, or disconnect notice)
- Proof of identification (Louisiana ID/driver's license, Social Security card, birth certificate for every resident in household)
- Verified income (check stubs, unemployment, Social Security, disability, etc.)
- Income not to exceed 30% of Average Median Income
- Landlord agreement to work with Program

TO RECEIVE ASSISTANCE

- Call (318) 221-7887 and mention Homelessness Prevention
- Every applicant is assessed to be certain all qualifications are met
- Once approved for assistance, the case management process begins
- The program aims to pay landlords and/or utilities within three business days after the initial case management visit
- The Homelessness Prevention team includes case management and workforce development specialists to help families move forward
